Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm by President Kathleen Seelig in the LBS Library.

Past Events

- The October Clothing Drive earned the PTA \$110, the most it's ever made.
- The PTA pizza lunch took place on Friday, 11/3, and was a success. Heather Berg helped distribute the pizza. She confirmed that we do not need disposable trays anymore.

Ongoing Events

- The Spirit Wear Sale began on Friday, 11/3. It is hosted on a new website. So far, it is going well with 11 orders and 23 products ordered. At present the PTA has made \$46. Kristen Abeles will go with Kathleen Seelig to pick up the orders when they come in.

Upcoming Events

- Vice President Heather suggested that the PTA sponsor a basketball and or multi-sports clinic for 6-8 weeks in January or February. She suggested having basketball for the upper grades and multi-sports for the lower. Mr. Torres may be able to tell us the best way to split this up. The multi-sports group would be lower in cost because it doesn't require additional equipment. Treasurer Brandon suggests this year we only buy a few more basketballs, instead of providing a basketball and pinnie for each student. This will keep costs down. Heather suggested that Pete Berg and Ruben Vloedgraven may be able to run this program.
- After the success of the Movie in the Park event, the Lebanon Rec Committee is interested in collaborating again, possibly combining with the town Bonfire on 1/6.
- The Scholastic Book Fair is coming up on 11/13-11/15. Natalie Tawil will be running this. She has sent a signup sheet requesting volunteers. She has reached out to a few teachers to be "secret readers" during the fair. Dr. Arcurio mentioned that we may be able to offer extended hours on one of the days, possibly 4-6:30pm. Rich, our custodian, could work from 6:30-7 on that day.

- We are participating in the Clinton Festival of Trees again this year. Kristen Abeles will run this, and the theme will be “Make a Wish”. The setup date for the tree will be 11/18, the Saturday before Thanksgiving.
- Kids Night Out
 - The date has been moved to 12/8 to avoid the Clinton parade.
 - Heather Berg will work on the volunteer form and registration form. It could go out in the Wildcats Road on 11/8.
 - Heather is finding teen volunteers for this. She will reach out to Girl Scouts, and Kathleen Seelig can reach out to the Boy Scouts Troop 200 or 288.
 - We will need a teacher to lead this. Mrs. Ingram mentioned she would be interested.
 - We could use the leftover snacks from the Movie Night.
 - PTA parent volunteers can communicate the details to the parents to drum up more support.
 - The price will be \$20 for the first child and \$10 for each additional sibling.
- The School Dance will now be on 2/2 to accommodate DJ Dan’s schedule. Angela Carlucci has an idea for the theme, based on the Taylo Swift “Eras” idea. We will need someone to help with snacks.
- TREPS
 - This will take place on 12/6 from 5-7pm.
 - Last year the PTA gave money to the teachers to aid in the cost of buying from the students. Mrs. Baldoni said that would be helpful again this year. We need to find out from Brandon Borzelli how much we donated last year.
 - Kristen Abeles mentioned the idea of coordinating between the PTA and TREPs to make TREPS available to larger audience of students. Heather Berg suggested providing a snack table sponsored by the PTA, with a donation cup.
