Lunch Program – Things are running smoothly with the lunch program. The online ordering system is up and running and for the most part, orders are being placed without an issue.

Resolution on legal fees – this is a result of our recent audit. The legal fees from the 2020/21 school year are what is used for the 2022 taxpayer guide and our costs were above the state average. We have to show that you are aware of that and that we have cost containment procedures in place as is listed in the administrative code.

Maintenance Reserve – there is a motion to withdraw funds for the cafeteria tables. If we can get a purchase order out this month, we can get the tables in place in April.

New Funding opportunities – We got notice today that there will be ROD grants available to apply for this year, the tricky part with the ROD grants is that you have to prove that you have matching funds available for use on the project in the application. We should be ok to move forward with air conditioning the gym if that is the direction you want to go in. There will be another grant for "emergent and capital maintenance needs" with a specific \$ amount allocated to us, I'm hoping there are some funds that can be used for the library HVAC system. The allocations have not been posted yet.

District's Policy 0167 - Public Participation in Board Meetings. The Board of Education recognizes the value of public comment on educational issues and the importance of allowing members of the public to express themselves on school matters of community interest. In order to permit the fair and orderly expression of such comment, the Board shall provide for two periods of public comments at every regularly scheduled meeting of the Board. Public participation shall be governed by the following rules:

- 1. A participant must be recognized by the presiding officer and must preface comments by an announcement of his or her name, place of residence, and group affiliation, if appropriate.
- 2. Each statement made by a participant shall be limited to a reasonable time as determined by the presiding officer.
- 3. No participant may speak more than once on the same topic until all others who wish to speak on that topic have been heard.
- 4. All statements shall be directed to the presiding officer; no participant may address or question Board members individually.
- 5. The presiding officer may
 - (a) Interrupt, warn, or terminate a participant's statement when the statement is too lengthy, personally directed, abusive, obscene, or irrelevant to the district;
 - *(b) Request any individual to leave the meeting when that person does not observe reasonable decorum;*
 - (c) Request the assistance of law enforcement officers in the removal of a disorderly person when that person's conduct interferes with the orderly progress of the meeting;
 - (d) Call for a recess or an adjournment to another time when the lack of public decorum so interferes with the orderly conduct of the meeting as to warrant such action; and waive these rules when necessary for the protection of privacy or the efficient administration of the Board's business.
