









Do you have children who will be eligible for preschool within the next 1-3 years? 92 responses






How important do you believe access to publicly funded preschool is for our community? 92 responses




If the state reduces or ends PEA funding, how would you prefer the district respond?








82.6% Very or Somewhat important to move 6th Grade to CPS




79.4% feel the changes would improve....

Do you support the proposed changes, given that they currently provide budget savings through preschool funding?


